1. PRESENTATION

On Tuesday, December 7, your group will present your work and insights from prior phone project assignments to the rest of the class. Each group will have 10 minutes to present. This time limit will be rigorously enforced in order to accommodate all groups.

We recommend structuring your presentation as follows:

- 2 minutes: Presentation of Application Idea
- 6 minutes: Presentation of Classification and Annotated Photos and Lessons Learned
- 2 minutes: Time for Q&A

We also require that every member of the team be given the opportunity to present. We strongly suggest that you practice your presentation, especially the switching between applications if you plan to do this, to make sure your presentation will run smoothly. Also, remember the acoustics in 202 South Hall—you will need to project your voice loudly and clearly to be heard and understood.

2. TOOLS

In order to best present your work, we recommend the following tools for your presentation, though use your own experience and judgment in determine the best tools for this presentation task:

- PowerPoint slides or a web page for your presentation
- MMM2 Web Site or PowerPoint slides or Protégé or some other tool or medium to present your faceted classification
- MMM2 Web Site or PowerPoint slides or some other tool or medium to present your photo annotation examples

All presentations must be linked to and accessible from your group web page. This will facilitate a quick transition from one group's presentation to the next.
