I. Make a simple website

Start creating a simple portfolio/about me page. We are aware that some of you might already have portfolio pages, but please create a new one for this assignment. Feel free to use the code from Lab 1 as a starting point or for inspiration.

At minimum, make sure to include:

- At least one image
- Your name
- Your email address
- A short description
- At least 3 CSS rules.
- A navigational link to your Part II page

If you want to get fancy, try making a fluid width page.

II. Updating the Lab

Here are some possible suggestions (but you are not limited to these):

- Delete button
- Drag and drop re-ordering
- Upvotes and Downvotes
- Toggle CSS changes

3. What is the value of the accesskey of the next button?

 - A description of your modifications you made for Part II
 - The URL to your hosted Part II website
 - Your answers to Part III
2. Your code from Part I and Part II
 3. Your screenshot from Part III
